Purpose: What were you trying to find out or accomplish?

Method: How did you proceed? What did you do?

Findings: What did you find out or accomplish? **Findings do not need to be research/practice policy**

RESEARCH ABSTRACT

Significance: What is the issue or gap in evidence, and why is it important?

Purpose: This is a concise statement of the specific aim or goal of the study. Study goals frequently describe, explain, or predict.

Method: This is a brief description of how the study was done. Mention the sampling method, ~~subject number~~, whether there was group assignment, and what the dependent and independent

Findings: Briefly describe what the primary findings of the study were. **Findings do not need to be complete**

Discussion: Describe how your findings fit into the 'larger' picture. What does your study add ~~to our~~ knowledge of this area? How can your findings be applied? What needs to be done in the
